A LOCKOUT PROCEDURE is a compulsory prevention method (article 185 RSST) that enables a worker to perform a maintenance job without the risk that the equipment he is servicing can be switched on accidentally.

**Interal Maintenance** allows you to establish processes adapted to the safety requirements for your workers regarding the maintenance, repair, locking and unlocking of your machinery and/or equipment.
