A LOCKOUT PROCEDURE is a compulsory prevention method (article 185 RSST) that enables a worker to perform a maintenance job without the risk that the equipment he is servicing can be switched on accidentally.

Internal Maintenance allows you to establish processes adapted to the safety requirements for your workers regarding the maintenance, repair, locking and unlocking of your machinery and/or equipment.

Create a safe environment at all times for your team...

- **Comprehensive information** as procedures include : Lockout procedure sequence, Starting and Operation testing, Unlocking procedure sequence;
- Lockout procedures, in the event of modifications are shown as "unapproved" automatically;
- **Information at the right time** since the lockout procedures are based on the equipment and are automatically printed on the work-order;
- **And much more information** since the lockout procedures also contains information about the lockout of nearby equipment for added safety.
